
THE LENTEN RETREAT "Grace: God's Life in Us" will be held at Our Lady of Victory on Sunday March 26th, and Monday March 27th.

We've all heard this at some time and now is the time for us all to roll up our sleeves and try to solve this problem. We need each and every person in this church to join the effort.

As PR warden I (Pauline Leduc) offer you this plan:

- 1. We create a business card for St. Aloysius
- 2. We give 10 cards to each attending parishioner; on-line parishioners can request them. Every time we hear, in our environment in Gatineau, a non-parishioner speaking English, we hand him/her a card simply saying: "In case you may not know we exist."
- 3. Every 2 months we tally how many cards were handed out and redistribute cards to attending parishioners; on-line parishioners can request more.
- 4. Our aim is to hand out 1,000 cards in 2023.

CONTEST FOR BUSINESS CARD:

The flip side of a business card often has a very short, dynamic slogan that, with a punch, tells its identity.

Today, March 19, 2023, we launch a contest, open to all parishioners, to suggest such a slogan for our business card. It must be short, 3 or 4 words; it must give an idea of the purpose of the parish; it must summarize why you like coming here. You can have as many suggestions as you wish; write them all down or send them by e-mail to the parish.

Sunday March 26, 2023 is the deadline for submissions. All will be typed on a ballot sheet.

Sunday April 2, 2023 all attending parishioners will be given a ballot sheet and asked to vote for **ONE** slogan. The ballot sheet will also be included in the bulletin on-line. The slogan with the most votes will be retained.

The cards will be printed and hopefully ready for distribution mid-April.
