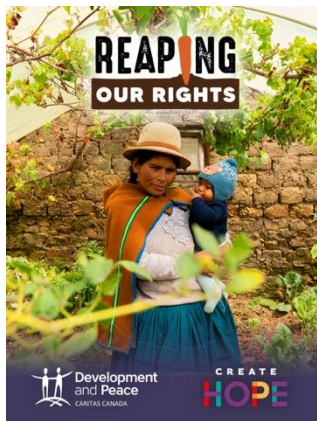

POPE FRANCIS CALLS THE FAITHFUL OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH TO BE "BUILDERS OF HOPE" FOR THE 2025 JUBILEE YEAR

"Hope does not disappoint." This is the theme for Jubilee 2025, which will begin on Christmas Eve, 2024, and continue throughout 2025, concluding on January 6, 2026. At Pope Francis's invitation, millions of Catholics around the world will participate in this Jubilee Year, celebrated every 25 years on a global scale. The Archdiocese of Gatineau is developing a plan to mark this Jubilee in a meaningful way.

An evening of spiritual renewal via Zoom will be held on Wednesday, December 4, featuring two guest speakers, including Pierre-Olivier Tremblay, Bishop of Hearst and originally from Gatineau. Additionally, to mark the start of the Jubilee Year, a celebration presided over by our bishop, Paul-André Durocher, will take place at St. Joseph's Cathedral on Sunday, December 29. Detailed information on all planned activities will be available soon.
