St-Aloysius Fundraiser – We need your help to pay for 2 new fire doors!



As you may have read in the recent financial update in the bulletin, the church has replaced two doors as a result of a City of Gatineau fire inspection report received last Spring. The new fire doors have already been installed given the timeline we were given by the city to do so. The cost of purchasing, installing, and keying the new doors is \$5000. Given this unexpected and unplanned for expense, we are seeking financial support from the parish to raise the funds necessary to cover these costs as our current budget will not allow us to do so.

If you wish to contribute towards this requirement, simply

drop off your contribution in the collection basket at the back of the church on Sundays. If you are using a collection envelope, please indicate "Fire Doors Fund" on the envelope and how much is offered for the fund. If you don't have collection envelopes, a standard envelope will do as well but be sure to indicate the Fire Doors Fund on it and your name and address if you wish to receive an income tax receipt at year end. All contributions from individuals will be eligible for income tax receipts. We thank you in advance for your support to the parish and your generosity in maintaining our beautiful church.
